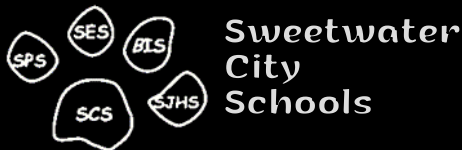

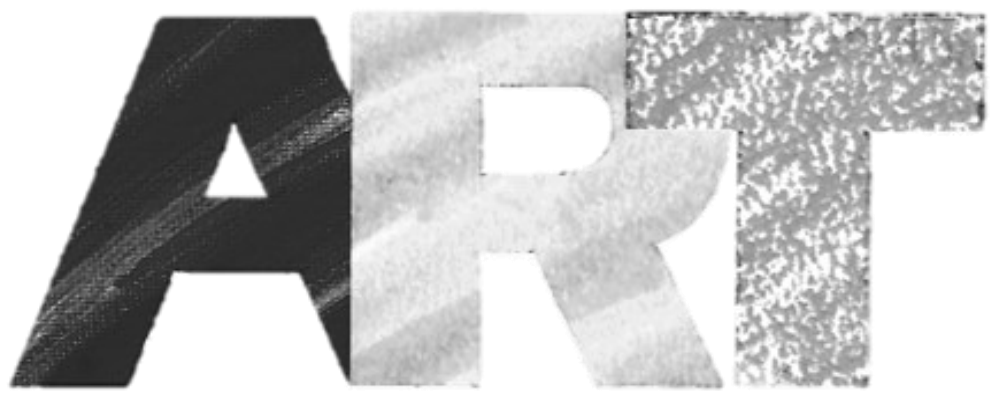
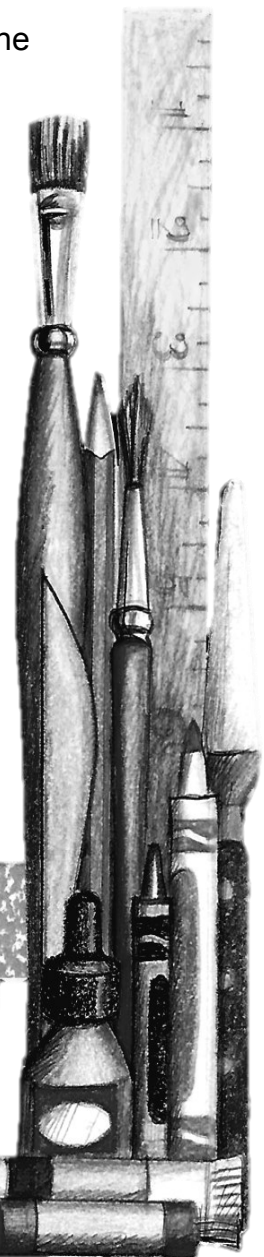

Members have exhibited at the Charles Hall Museum in Tellico Plains. We have participated with talks about the visual arts with teachers at the Intensive Art Camps at Monroe County schools.

## Introduction

The Monroe Area Council for the Arts, Monroe County Schools and Sweetwater City Schools present the 2019 Monroe County Student Juried Art Show, open to all Middle, High, Home Schooled, Private Schooled and Full Time College Students up to 22 years who reside in Monroe County.

This first Monroe County Student Juried Art Show is intended to showcase the artistic talents of our students, encourage creativity, to recognize students and their artworks, honor teachers in our school system, parents and guardians and the schools in Monroe County and to 'Support Arts in Education'.

Our objective is to stimulate creative ideas, express artistic abilities and our ultimate goal is to have an entertaining and interesting art exhibit for all our viewers.



# Entry Information

This is a family-friendly art show, any work deemed unsuitable will be rejected by the discretion of the Juror. Only art produced within the school calendar year August 2018 to May 2019 can only be entered: teacher/parent/guardian to verify this on entry form. Original artworks will only be accepted (no reproductions or copies permitted) except for digital art. Submitted art is limited to three per student and all accepted art that meets the criteria of this competition will be exhibited. All media will be acceptable including, but not limited to: drawing, painting, printmaking, ceramics, sculpture, photography, glass, wood/metal art, fiber arts, fine handmade crafts, digital and recycled art.

All entries will be exhibited that meet the Juror's and the show's criteria, all artworks will have an Entry Label with artist's name, title, medium, name of school, grade, age, teacher/parent/guardian signatures. Contact information: address, phone and email address on separate label and price, if for sale or (NFS) if art is not for sale. Please note that a 10% commission on sales will be donated to Monroe Area Council for the Arts to help support activities for future school art programs including the Art Camps. All sales will be conducted by MACA. Monies from sales will be distributed minus 10% within two weeks from the closing of the show.

For the purpose of publicity, students and all artworks entered and exhibited can be photographed and the images and copyright may be used on websites, social media and any promotional activities for this art show and any future materials. By submitting entries to this art show, everyone will constitute acceptance of this copyright release to MACA, Monroe County Schools and Sweetwater City Schools.



## Monroe Area Council for the Arts

## Juror and Media

The Juror will be a Professor of Art from a Tennessee University or College, an art professional/instructor who is well respected within the creative arts world. The appointed juror will evaluate all submitted work, present awards and will give an overview, critique of some of the exhibits and talk about the importance of creativity and art education in our schools.

We will request local radio, television, newspaper and media coverage. Galleries, businesses, art patrons and dignitaries will be invited to the opening reception and awards presentation to be held at Vonore Middle School, 411 Hall Street, Vonore, TN. 37885. May 9, 2019. 6 – 8 pm. Awards 6:30 pm.

## Delivering Artworks

All artworks to be hand delivered to the MACA office, 520 Cook Street, Madisonville, TN 37354 on **Monday, May 6** and **Tuesday, May 7** between **9 am and 4 pm**. Vonore Middle School will hold their entries until 8 am Wednesday May 8, when the exhibition will be set up and the artworks will be displayed and juried. **NO ARTWORKS WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT A COMPLETED ENTRY LABEL ATTACHED TO EACH PIECE OF ART** (see diagrams)

## Displaying and Labeling Artworks

All two dimensional art to be mounted onto black card, allow 2 inches on top, left and right side of image and 3 inches at the bottom of the image. Attached Entry Label with artist's information to the lower right hand corner to the black card. (Please see diagram) All three dimensional art will be required with solid base/stand or is securely mounted making sure the Entry Label is secured by string or tape to the art.

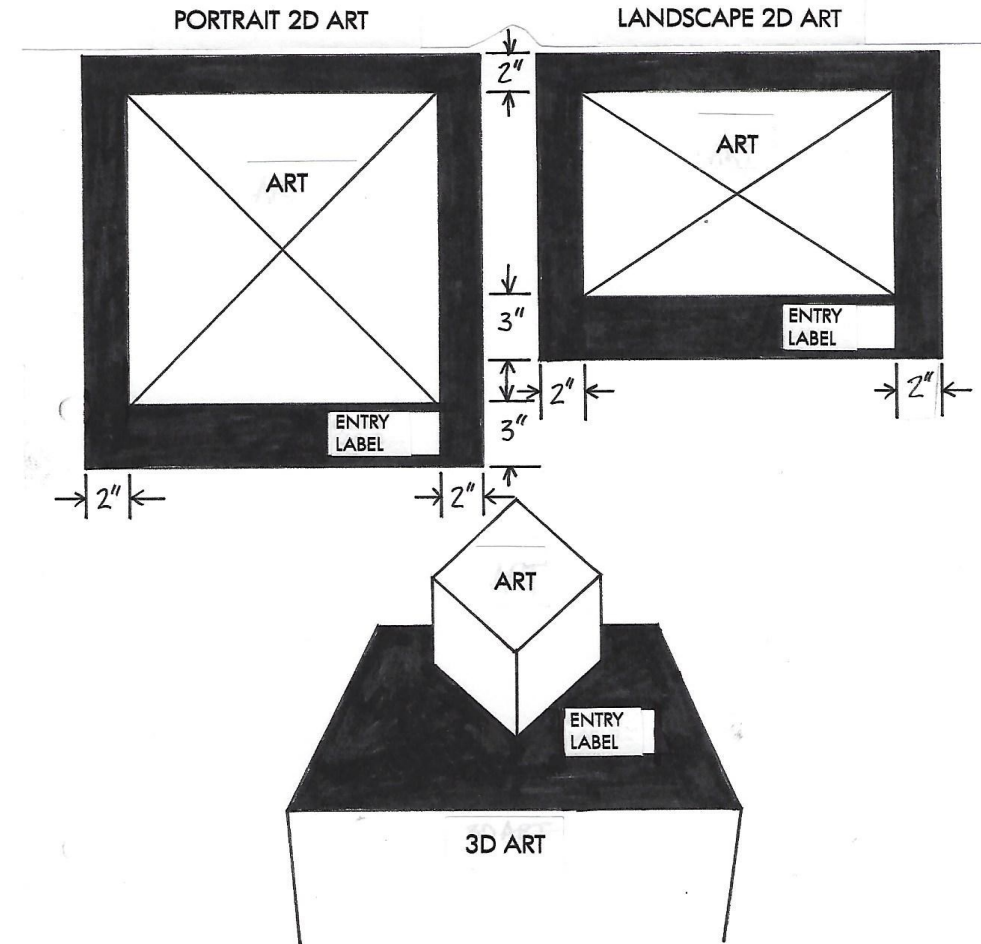
